30th Annual Fall Classic Breeder's Sale!*

Please read through the nomination package and reach out to our Admin Team with any questions. We are here to assist you in selling your quality horse for a good price. Our job is to market your horse, as presented, to our network via social media, our website and our auction platform. In order to do this well, we need your help by bring a well prepared, exceptionally turned-out horse to presentation days. In addition to this, as much complete information as you can, submitted online, is extremely advantageous. This includes show video and professional show photos for the performance horses, well written catalogue notes and detailed/complete vet information.

In your catalogue notes for young horses and broodmares please include comments regarding siblings from the mother-line who are doing well in sport, as well as any accolades that your young horse has achieved themselves. Inclusion of both foal and broodmare inspection results is helpful. We cannot market what we do not have on video or photos!

How to Proceed For Nominations

- **Nomination Deadline is July 22nd, 2024**
- Complete the nomination form online at www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca with payment completed online (if you require alternative arrangements please contact the Sale Admin)
- Send the following Nomination Documents after submission to admin@cwauktion.ca:
 - Scan of the horse's registration certificate or proof of pending registration

- Scan the EC/ESEF/FEI passport for Performance (we are looking for the page with the Passport #)
- Proof of Performance Record Required for all horses age 5 and older (if applicable)
- Send a conformation photo of the horse standing in the open stance, taken from the side
- Signed Seller Declaration
- You will be notified by email of your horses' acceptance no later than August 1st, 2024

How to Proceed After Acceptance

- **Acceptance Notification is August 1st, 2024 @ 6 PM MST**
- After receiving notification of acceptance by email, you will be required to do the following:
 - Pay the balance of the Nomination Fee (see payment schedule)
 - Submit 'Catalogue Notes' no later than August 15th, 2024 for the nominate horse, its sire and its dam
 - Competition photos and videos of Performance Horses submitted no later than September 1st, 2024
 - All nominate horses are required to attend one of the Presentation Days (August 23rd – August 26th)

Presentation Days

- **Presentation Days will be Friday August 23rd – Monday August 26th at Old Gate Farms in Olds, Alberta**
- All horses must have a Current Negative ELISA/Coggins drawn no later than August 9th, 2024 to attending Presentation Days (this test is valid for all sale requirements, and both mare and foal must be tested)
- Our Sale Office will contact you to book your Presentation Day spot
- Limited stabling is available during the presentation days. Please contact our office to book your spot
- At Presentation Days your horse will be professionally filmed and photographed in free movement as well as free jumping and riding under saddle where applicable
- Professional conformation, head shots, leg shots and a walk video will be completed too. Marketing material will be available to each consignor for their own advertising use
- Each consignor must be a current member in good standing with CWHBA to attend Presentation Days. Please contact office@canadianwarmbloods.com for membership inquiries
- All individuals attending the Presentation Day **MUST** bring either their CWHBA Membership Number or their personal AEF Membership for insurance purposes. No exceptions will be granted.

After the Sale

- Sold horses will be insured with BFL insurance for 10 days following the close of the sale (October 30th, 2024)
- The seller is obligated to provide board at no extra charge for up to 10 days following the close of the sale (October 30th, 2024)

Terms, Conditions, Limiting Criteria & Governing Policy

Basic Eligibility

Horses eligible for nomination must be registered Canadian Warmblood (CWHBA) or with another recognized Warmblood registry:

Warmblood registries which are recognized with WBFSH, but not limited to:

- AES
- Belgium (BWP)
- Danish (DWB)
- Dutch (KWPN)
- Hanoverian (AHHS, Han)
- Holsteiner
- Oldenburg (GOC + OS)
- Selle Francais (ANSF)
- Swedish (SWB)
- Trakehner
- Westfalan (WESTF)
- Zangersheide (ZANG)

Providing horses meet CWHBA standards for warmblood registration:

- Canadian Sport Horse (CSHA)
- Oldenburg Registry North America (ISR – OLD)

Limiting Criteria

- Priority will be given to CWHBA registered horses at the discretion of the Sale Committee
- Special consideration MAY be given to horses with an exceptional show record or with siblings from the direct mother-line with exceptional show records
- Approximately 45 lots will be accepted for the 2024 Fall Classic Breeder's Sale
- Other Limiting Criteria may be based off of Performance and/or Pedigree – including but not limited to dam approval scores and stallion approval/licensing
- All selections are at the sole discretion of the Sale Committee
- In your nomination, please include as much information as possible about your horse's performance record, schooling shows, ability (free jump video for a jumper prospect or free movement for dressage prospects where it would be an asset), other noteworthy siblings out of the dam-line and any other pertinent information for the selection committee to make their decision
- The classifications for the categories are as follow with age as of January 1st of the year of nomination:

Broodmare <i>Must be 15 years of age of under</i>	Broodmares must be 60 pregnant at time of sale and have a pregnancy that confirmed between <u>August 19th – August 21st</u> , 2024 Meets breed eligibility requirements (including inspection) and have been bred by a stallion entered in the CWHBA Studbook. They must perform the same basic PPE and weanlings and yearling.
Weanling	It is recommended that they are shown at their dam's side, although may be shown without. Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness.
Yearling	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness. Basic x-ray requirement is recommended but not mandatory.
Two-Year-Old Prospect	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness and basic x-ray requirement.
Prospects <i>3 to 6 years of age</i>	Must be 3 to 6 years of age. 3 years old – started under saddle <u>or</u> ready to start under saddle. Preference MAY be given to horses that are started. 4 years or older – must be started under saddle
Performance Horses <i>Must be 5 to 12 years of age</i>	Performance horses must have shown at a minimum of two EC or USEF rated shows or have proof of attending five schooling shows in the past 18 months. Preference MAY be given to horse with an outstanding show record.

Nomination Information

- All owners agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will provide the sale with all required veterinarian documentation including: x-rays, EIA, insurance forms, vaccination record, medication form and videoed flexion tests (horses 3 and older). These will be sent to the admin team ON TIME. Failure to do so will forfeit all fees and your horse will not be sold through the sale.
- All owners agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will allow them to be tested for any banned substances according to the Equine Canada Medication Control Committee. Every horse must have blood drawn at their PPE and it must be held by the sellers vet for 45 days after the sale.
- Where the owner of a horse is a partnership, limited company, ranch or farm, all legal signatories must sign the nomination form and sale Terms and Conditions.
- All truthful information and representations of the horses consigned are the sole responsibility of the seller or agent of the seller, as per the sale Terms and Conditions.

- The seller acknowledges they have read and agree to the full sale Terms and Conditions.
- All original papers for North American breed registries must be turned into our office no later than the presentation days, along with the corresponding, signed transfer of ownership forms. European Passports/papers should be transferred directly to the buyer.
- Proof of transfer will be required for sale disbursement to take place. In the case of a pending registration, the registration form must be completed, DNA included (20 hairs from the root) with the DNA form and proof of submission to the respective registry sent in to our office no later than (DATE)

Withdrawals & Refunds

- Applies to all horses that are consigned
- Withdrawal before August 15th, 2024 all fees refunded less the Admin Fee (\$150.00)
- Withdrawal between August 15th, 2024 – September 7th, 2024 all Nomination Fees refunded at 50%
- Withdrawal after September 7th, 2024 no refunds will be issues

Commissions

A flat rate commission will be charged on each horse sold at the following rate:

9%	On horses sold for less than \$30 000.00 CAD
8%	On horses sold for \$30 001.00 CAD to \$50 000.00 CAD
7%	On horses sold for more than \$50 001.00 CAD

No selling commission will be charged for horses who are not sold. The last bidder **must** be the listed owner OR pre-disclosed agent for this to be valid. The Sale Admin must be notified **immediately** after the close of the sale if the bidder represented the owner.

Minimum Bids

- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$4 000.00 CAD for weanling, yearlings, 2-year-olds and broodmares
- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$6 000.00 CAD for prospects and performance horses

Final Disbursements

1. The CWHBA Alberta Chapter acts only as a clearing house for funds collected for and on behalf of the seller
2. GST is collected for and on behalf of the seller **ONLY** when the seller provides a valid GST registration # prior to the close of the sale
3. Consignor's accounts will be settled when the bank hold has been released from the purchaser's funds – please note payment method by seller with determine length of hold time
4. Payments will be sent via Cheque or E-transfer – any outstanding amounts owing will be deductive from your payment at this time
5. Each consignor will be issues a single payment to settle the account. For multiple consignments, settlement will occur when final purchaser funds are released
